TOP BRASS

This sparkling brass plate captures the playful essence of a palm frond in motion. Its dramatic branches call to mind windswept vistas and endless summers. SEA SCULPTURE

Artist **Junko Mori** makes breathtaking sculptures brought to life from forged metal coated in wax. Works inspired by organic patterns that bear the imprint of the formation of waves. Mori was moved to create a response to the earthquake and tsunami in her native Japan. This piece brings to mind a braced or charred seashell that has been extracted from the depths of the sea.
